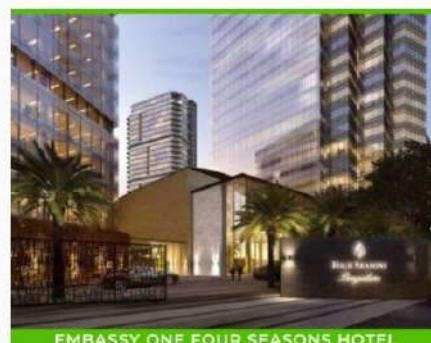
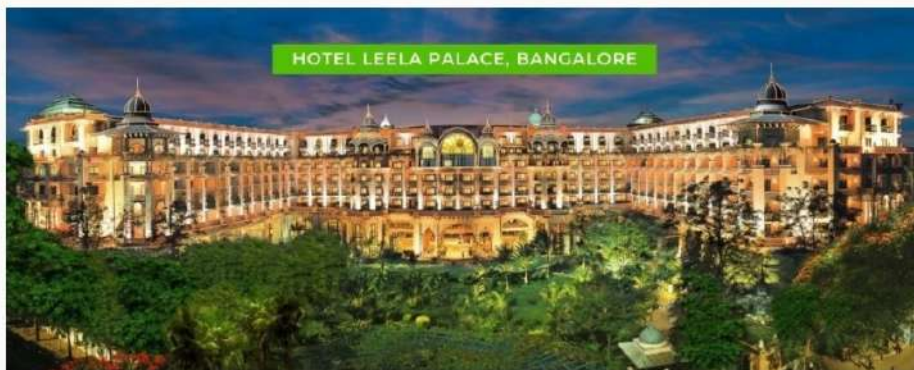

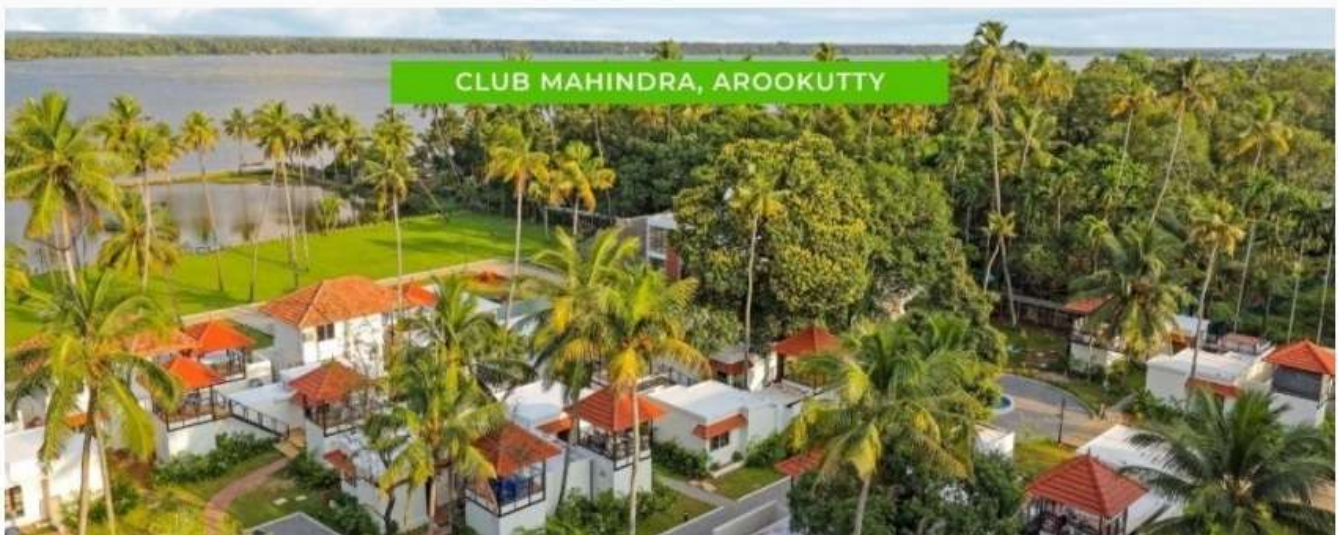
RTM Installations

Real Time Monitoring systems (RTMs) for Sewage Treatment Plants (STPs) were installed in the World Trade Center-Bangalore (WTCB), Sheraton Hotel, Embassy GolfLinks Business Park, Embassy One Four Seasons Hotel, RMZ Ecoworld 5 A & 5 B, Hotel Leela Palace, Co Evolve Northern Star Residential Apartments and Club Mahindra Alapuzha (Arookutty).





The WTCB, having a height of 128 meters is considered to be the tallest commercial building in south India. GolfLinks is one of the flagship office parks with 4.5 million Sq. ft. of fully developed office space, which is spread across 65 acres of land.

Jal Jeevan Mission

3 Crore Tap water connections in 2020



In the last one year, more than 3 Crore tap water connections were provided under Jal Jeevan Mission despite the delays and disruptions caused by the Covid19 pandemic. With this, the number of households with taped water connections have now increased to 6,24,29,320 households.

The achievement has a special significance as all the works have been badly affected due to lockdown in most parts of the country. As on 15th August 2019, when the Mission was launched, out of 18.93 Crore rural households in India, only 3.23 Crore (17%) had tap water connections.

The Mission's motto of 'Har Ghar Jal' (water at every household) has become a reality in 26 districts, 457 Blocks, 34,919 Panchayats and 65,627 villages during the year by giving Functional Household Tap Connection (FHTC) every family. Goa has become the first State in the country to provide 100% FHTCs and became 'Har Ghar Jal' State.

Price of Water



Rs. 888 (US\$ 12) for a one litre bottled water! *Report published in numbeo.com* says that a small bottle (.33 litre) of drinking water can be as costly as Rs. 296/- (US\$ 4.11) in Switzerland, in restaurants. The report also says that the same quantity of bottled water costs just Rs. 15/ per 0.33 litre in India (USD 0.21), whereas in Bangladesh it costs only Rs. 13/- ((USD 0.18).
